Approve the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board’s request that the Owners pass legislation to amend the 2022 Budget to increase the appropriations on the Water line (J8130.54221) by \$20,000 with a corresponding reduction in Contingency (J8130.55000).

### **Resolution 337 of 2022**

Approve the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board's request that the Owners pass legislation to amend the 2022 Budget to increase the appropriations on the Gas/Diesel line (J8130.54112) by \$9,000 with a corresponding reduction in Contingency (J8130.55000).

### **Resolution 338 of 2022**

Approve the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board's request that the Owners pass legislation to amend the 2022 Budget to increase J.43960 State Aid - Emergency Disaster Asst by \$75,478.31, J.44960 Fed Aid - Emergency Disaster Assist by \$226,434.95.
