Whereas, said Program proposals were received March 30, 2016 at 10:00 am; and

Whereas, the Village received one proposal from Utility Service Co., Inc. for full service asset management and maintenance of the water storage facilities on Wren Street, and

Now, therefore be it resolved, that the proposal for a Full Service Water Storage Tank Asset Management and Maintenance Program as submitted by Utility Service Group be accepted with delivery of the Program services and the payment schedule contingent upon execution of a

final agreement between the Village Utility Services Co., Inc. in a form and containing terms and conditions acceptable to counsel for the Village; and be it further,

Resolved, that the total four year cost for said Program shall not exceed the following amounts:

Wren Street East Tank Pricing (years 1 – 3) - \$481,884.00

Annual Cost (Year 4) - \$60,914.00

(costs will increase 3.5% each year annually for up to 30 years)

Total 4 Year Cost - \$1,506,566.00

Wren Street West Tank Pricing (years 1-3) - \$481,884.00 Annual Cost (Year 4) - \$60,914.00 (costs will increase 3.5% each year annually for up to 30 years) Total 4 Year Cost - \$1,506,566.00
