### **Resolution #2016 – 83**

Approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Century Sunrise Redevelopment, LLC ("Century Sunrise") has submitted a plan for the adaptive reuse of the former factory building and warehouse located at 135-139 Baldwin Street into 104 residential units and 7,745 square feet of commercial space; and

WHEREAS, the Broome County Industrial Development Agency ("The Agency") has received an application from Century Sunrise for financial assistance, including a deviated PILOT; and

WHEREAS, the Agency will hold a public hearing on the Century Sunrise Application May 16, 2016 at 5:30pm at Village Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Agency requires the approval of the Chief Elected Official of the municipality where the project is located as part of The Agency approval process; and

WHEREAS, the Century Sunrise PILOT is estimated to generate \$999,083.73 in revenue for the taxing jurisdictions (Village, JCCSD, Town and County) over the thirty (30) year PILOT in addition to meaningful water, sewer and refuse charges for the Village; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Trustees hereby directs and authorizes the Mayor to execute and deliver Village consent to The Agency to permit the Agency to fully consider the Century Sunrise application.



### **Resolution #2016 - 84**

Authorize a parade permit to be issued to the VFW Alfred & Henry Michalovic Post 2332 and the Frank A. Johnson American Legion Post 758 to hold a Memorial Day Parade on May 30, 2016 starting at 10:00am at Ozalid Road to Main Street traveling west to the Gazebo for a formal ceremony subject to providing the appropriate liability insurance and coordination with the Village Police Dept. and the Department of Public Works.

#### **Resolution #2016 - 85**
