Resolution #2018 - 2

Authorize the Mayor to sign an engagement letter with Coughlin & Gerhart, LLP, Cheryl Sacco, Lead Counsel, whereby Coughlin & Gerhart, LLP will provide legal services to the Village; and be it Further Resolved, that Coughlin & Gerhart, LLP, is authorized to represent the Village in the prosecution of parking tickets and code violations from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

Resolution #2018 - 3

WHEREAS, the Village of Johnson City scheduled a public hearing for January 2, 2018 at 7:35 p.m. for Local Law No. 1 of the year 2018 entitled "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 208 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED 'PROPERTY MAINTENANCE'"; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly advertised in the official newspaper of the Village and posted on the Village Clerk's sign board; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing was duly opened at the Village Hall, 243 Main Street, Johnson City, New York on the 2nd day of January, 2018 at 7:35 p.m. and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 617 of the implementing regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, it has been determined by the Village Board that adoption of the proposed Local Law constitutes an Unlisted Action, as defined under said regulations. The Village Board has considered the possible environmental impacts of the Local Law. The adoption of said Local Law will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and the Village Board adopts a negative declaration with respect to the Local Law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village to adopt said Local Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board hereby adopts said Local Law as Local Law No. 1-2018 entitled "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 208 OF THE VILLAGE CODE ENTITLED 'PROPERTY MAINTENANCE'", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Village Clerk be and hereby is directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution will take effect immediately.
