Discussion – Trustee Reynolds – Thanked everyone for their hard work and said that he is pleased that the rate is where it is. He said that he knows that took a lot to get it to where it was. He had been thinking for days pertaining to this vote.

- Mayor Deemie Thanked everyone for all the hard work that went into getting the budget were we got it and the bonding lower than it has been.
- Trustee Meaney Also thanked everyone for their hard work. He agreed that the budget was at a good place but wanted to clarify his stance pertaining to dues and meals. He felt there was a total of \$2,105 that could have been cut from dues and \$600 from meals, (document on file with meeting minutes). He also thought that possibly the monies that were cut from dues and meals could have been used towards the school swim program.
- Trustee Walker's expressed concern that the monies that is currently in the budget for roads wasn't enough to get ahead. All were in agreement that we need to get a plan in-place to move forward with the road preservation and to get more roads done sooner, rather than later.
- Trustee Giblin discussed his desire for the micro paving program.

Clerk-Treasurer Kennerup explained the changes that had been made and why.

- Mayor explained the road monies that were already in the budget should this program be ready to start in this budget year and that the roads are a concern of everyone along with staying under the tax cap, keeping bonding down and continuing to make progress within the Village.
- Trustee Giblin asked Trustee Reynolds why he voted no on the Budget.
- Trustee Reynolds stated that he had been thinking about it all weekend and on the drive down and that he voted no because of his disappointment that there was not a confirmation to move forward with the pool and in losing Field days; he remembered these things when he was growing up.
- Trustee Giblin stated that the Field days has nothing to do with the Village it was a decision made by the Celebration Committee and there was money put in the budget pool line so that we could continue to look into the best avenue for all the constituents village wide.

Mayor Deemie, Trustee Meaney and Trustee Walker were all in agreement with Trustee Giblin's comments and they discussed the pool or spray park options further.

**Resolution #2019 – 76** A motion was made by Trustee Meaney and Seconded by Trustee Giblin to declare the 2013 Elgin Street Sweeper/Vac - VIN #1FVACXDT6DHFD2338 as surplus.
