Resolution #2019 – 193

Motion to accept the grant from the Department of Justice Office for Crime Victims, in conjunction with RISE, this grant reimburses the cost of placing a domestic violence victim specialist within the police department for a 3 year period and the victim specialist is an employee of RISE who will work out of the Village's Police station 3 to 4 days per week, effective immediately.

Resolution #2019 – 194

Motion to accept the grant from the Broome County District Attorney's Office, in the amount of \$30,000 to replace the Village's critical incident response vehicle; such vehicle is utilized to respond to all critical incidents in JC, Binghamton, and the Town of Vestal which require the use of the Metro SWAT team, effective immediately.

Resolution #2019 – 195

Appoint Chris Cody to the position of Emergency Services Dispatcher Part-Time within the Police Department at a starting salary of \$16.00 per hour, to be effective on or after October 28, 2019 contingent upon the successful completion of a background check.

Resolution #2019 – 196

WHEREAS, the Village Board wishes to adopt a resolution discontinuing the section of Saint Charles Street, a portion of St Charles Street approximately 115' long on the west side and 140' long on the east side between Corliss Avenue and the railroad tracks, pursuant to Village Law § 6-612; and

WHEREAS, Village Law § 6-614 requires a notice of a public hearing to consider a resolution discontinuing a street, and that such hearing be conducted as provided in Article 21 of the Village Law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to hold a public hearing with respect to the adoption of a resolution discontinuing the section of Saint Charles Street beginning at a dead end and ending at Corliss Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing will be held by the Village Board of the Village of Johnson City with respect to the adoption of the aforesaid resolution at 7:35 p.m. on November 19 2019, at Village Hall, 243 Main Street, Johnson City, New York, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause public notice of said hearing to be given as provided by law.
