PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to a motion of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City, Broome County, New York, sealed bids for the following project: OVERBROOK ROAD WATER LINE REPLACEMENT in the Village of Johnson City, New York, will be received by the Village Clerk at 60 Lester Ave, Johnson City, New York until 10:00 a.m. on the 10th day of March 2026, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes at the above address and shall bear on the face thereof the name and address of the bidder and shall be marked:

It is the Contractor's responsibility to meet the minimum guidelines of the Occupational Safety and Health Act (O.S.H.A.), Part 1926, the Safety and Health Regulations for Construction. The Village Engineer has the authority to issue a Stop Work Order if the applicable O.S.H.A. regulations are violated. The Stop Work Order will remain in effect until such violations of the O.S.H.A. regulations have been rectified.
