

Town of Union Tax Collection Schedule for 2020

*Credit and Debit card payments can be made on your tax bill from January 1st until March 31st 2020. Go to www.taxlookup.net and follow the directions. There is a convenience fee charged by the bank on credit or debit payments of 2.9%. **On April 1st 2020 your unpaid taxes become delinquent and this form of payment can no longer be accepted.**

*To confirm your tax is paid, go to www.taxlookup.net and search for *Payment History*; this website is updated through March 31st 2020. If you pay in person, the tax collector will stamp your bill paid.

*Do not pay multiple towns/city with one check – separate check required for each town.

*Do not staple, tape or paperclip your payment to the coupon.

January: Daily Monday through Friday (No penalty)
February: Friday February 28th and Monday March 2nd (1% penalty)
March: Tuesday, March 31st (2% penalty +\$1.⁰⁰)**

Walk-in payments are accepted Monday through Friday from 8 am until 4 pm on the Second Floor of the Broome County Office Building, 60 Hawley Street, Binghamton, NY, except for holidays.

5) A lock box is available for drop off payments at the Town of Union Town Hall.

DELINQUENT TAX INFORMATION:

- 1) If you have delinquent taxes and wish to pay the full amount due call (607) 778-2161 for that information.
- 2) Delinquent taxes can be paid by entering an Installment Agreement, which requires a 25% down payment with 24 monthly payments at 1% interest per month. During the agreement all new taxes must be paid on time. For more information or to set up an agreement, call our AUTOMATED TAX LINE at (607) 778-6431. You will be asked to leave the necessary information and your call will be returned with details on the program.
- 3) **You MAY NOT pay delinquent taxes with Credit or Debit card.**
