Northside Residents – Zoa Ave, Leigh St, Miriam St, Virginia Ave

Weather permitting, Thursday November 3, 2022, Village crews and our paving contractor will be top coat paving asphalt on Leigh St from Zoa Ave to the Village line at Ukrainian Hill, Zoa Ave from Wren St. to just south of the intersection of Miriam St. and Miriam St from Zoa Ave to the intersection of Virginia Ave. During the Paving Operations these Roads will be closed, minimal local traffic may be allowed. Expect traffic delays in the area during the Paving process. Residents will not have access to their driveways during the paving process. We ask that all vehicles be removed from roadways by 6:00am Thursday Morning. Thank You

We will attempt to pave the entire width of the roadway in these locations in one day
